Now retired from my trade, seeking to do something with my spare time I joined Meals on Wheels as a delivery driver, not long after that I was asked to join the board as the treasurer.




I am immensely proud to be able help with this project, and amazed to see the many other volunteers also doing their bit to help, it certainly gives hope that the world is a good place to be.


